RE: Foundation Game Information

Below is information concerning the NCS Foundation Game Scholarship Program. One hundred percent of the revenue forwarded to the NCS Office is used to award as many \$1,000 scholarships as possible each year. I encourage all NCS member school to participate and thank those schools who have already committed to the conduct of a NCS Foundation Game in 2011 and 2012.

Parameters of the conduct of a NCS Foundation Game

- Foundation Games will be played on the Tuesday prior to Thanksgiving each year. Please note that only foundation games may be played on the foundation date. No other basketball competition is permitted, at any level. The NCS Office has not, and will not, grant exceptions to this date.
- All levels of competition are permitted as part of the Foundation Games. When varsity boy and girl teams are scheduled as a double header, the participating schools may, at their discretion, hold non-varsity competition in conjunction with the varsity double header or at the opposite site. ***Since these sub-varsity contests are held on the Foundation Date the NCS Office will not count these contests towards the maximum number of contests limit set by NCS member schools.***
- **RECOMMENDED GAME TIMES**
7:00 for a single game, 6:00 & 8:00 for a double header, 4:30, 6:00 & 8:00 for a triple header (The NCS Office has agreed to adjustment of game times due to a potential conflict with the hosting school's participation in the CIF Nor-Cal Volleyball Championships).
- **CONTRACTS**
Schools must agree to a two-year contract. The contract must be signed by both principals and returned to the Section office for final approval. The contract form is available by clicking on the link on the NCS website (www.cifncs.org/forms/files/Found.game.two-yr.agree.pdf).
- **CIF MEMBER SCHOOLS ONLY**
Both participants must be CIF members. Out-of-State play is not allowed. The NCS member school must share revenue with the Section when it hosts a Foundation Game. A CIF school from another Section is not expected to share gate revenue with NCS for the game that it hosts.
- **TICKET PRICES**
Adults--\$5.00 Students--\$3.00
- **MAXIMUM NUMBER OF CONTACTS**
Games do not count toward the NCS 26-maximum number of contest limit and are not calculated in the school's overall record (similar to an Alumni Game).
- **OFFICIALS**
The home team is responsible for securing officials (officials may agree to waive their fees for these games).
- **GATE RECEIPTS**
Half of the gate receipts (after expenses) are to be forwarded to the North Coast Section office with Foundation Game Invoice Form. The invoice form is available by clicking on the link on the NCS website (www.cifncs.org/scholarship_foundation_games/files/foundgameinv.pdf).
